CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LANGFORD- HAMILTON CORPORATION

confirms the right to use the waters of EILER CREEK, a tributary of GALES CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 3.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 17618. The date of priority is MARCH 19, 1947. This right is limited to 0.045 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 7, T 1 N, R 4 W, WM; 1480 FEET SOUTH AND 1480 FEET EAST FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW NE 3.6 ACRES SECTION 7 TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
