## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HENRY J. GORDEN FORT KLAMATH, OREGON 97626

confirms the right to use the waters of ANNA CREEK, a tributary of the WOOD RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 113.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for KLAMATH County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 2, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1902 FOR TRACT 1, 1907 FOR TRACT 2, AND 1892 FOR TRACT 3.

The use is limited to 1.42 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND from APRIL 1st to JULY 20th of each year and 0.71 CFS thereafter until the close of the irrigation season, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
