confirms the right to use the waters of the Malheur River, a tributary of the Snake River, in the Malheur River Basin to maintain an instream flow for fish life uses.

The right is for flows to be maintained in Malheur River from Logan Valley, river mile 190, Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 33 1/2 East, WM downstream to the upper Drewsey Valley Diversion, river mile 172.8, SE 1/4, Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, WM.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statute 537.341.


The date of priority is May 11, 1990.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the periods listed below:

<u>Period</u>	<u>Flows (in cubic feet per second)</u>
October 1 through January 31	35
February 1 through July 31	50
August 1 through September 30	35
