confirms the right to use the waters of Malheur River, a tributary of the Snake River, in the Malheur River Basin to maintain an instream flow for fish life uses.

The right is for flows to be maintained in Malheur River from the Upper Drewsey Valley Diversion at river mile 172, SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, WM to the Highway 20 crossing at river mile 142, SE 1/4, Section 31, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, WM.

The right is established under Oregon Revised Statute 537.341.


The date of priority is May 11, 1990.

The right is limited to not more than the amounts during the periods listed below:

<u>Period</u>	<u>Flows (in cubic feet per second)</u>
October 1 through December 31	15
January 1 through June 30	40
July 1 through July 31	30
August 1 through September 30	15
