CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 1 ON UNIT 1 for IRRIGATION OF 11.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-487. The date of priority is MARCH 4, 1952. This right is limited to 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 27, T 27 S, R 17 E, WM; 2640 FEET SOUTH AND 2660 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  3.2 ACRES  
SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  8.0 ACRES  
SECTION 27  
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 17 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 51862, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 25, 1994, approving Transfer Application 6614.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
