CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That HENRY KOCH

of Howard State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Ochoco, Douthit, and Garden Creeks, tributary of Crooked River, and springs,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 55 acres of land, and stock and domestic use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of

Oregon for Crook

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem,
in the Order Record of the Record of the Record of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at
page 449; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1885

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for stock and domestic use, and 69/100 cubic foot per second for irrigation, the total quantity being limited to four acres feet per acre during each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system orders by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

13 acres in the SW1 of SW2; 3 acres in the SE1 of SW2; 20 acres in the NE1 of NE1; 6 acres in the NW1 of NE1; 12 acres in the SW2 of NE2; 1 acre in the SE1 of NE1; Section Four (4) Township Fourteen (14) South Range Nineteen (19) East of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
