## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W. W. LUCAS AND VIOLA A. LUCAS BAKER CITY, OREGON 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of the POWDER RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 59.7 acres.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is 1887 for 59.7 acres.

The use is limited to 1.49 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

## HENDERSON DITCH

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
