This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DOUGLAS County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 11, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1908.

The use is limited to ONE CUBIC FOOT OF WATER PER SECOND OF TIME FOR EACH 70 ACRES OF LAND IRRIGATED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW¼ NE¼ 2.0 ACRES NW¼ SE¼ 0.6 ACRE SECTION 5

TOWNSHIP 32 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the purposes of the water right and supersedes Certificate 68371, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
