## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES E. GRAY AND JOHN B. BURR 1108 PAWNEE CIRCLE SE SALEM, OREGON 97306

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATING 41.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permits G-5841 AND G-7281. The dates of priority are JUNE 1, 1973, FOR PERMIT G-5841; AND FEBRUARY 25, 1977, FOR PERMIT G-7281. This right is limited to 0.52 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.25 CFS FOR 20.1 ACRES UNDER PERMIT G-5841; AND 0.27 CFS FOR 21.6 ACRES UNDER G-7281, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well. The quantity of water diverted at the new well shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN IN DLC 51, SECTION 5, T 7 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 710 FEET SOUTH AND 400 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF MUNKERS DLC 51.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the Department, the user shall install an inline flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

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This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 12, 1991, and together with Certificate 65486, supersedes Certificate 46904 AND BY AN ORDER OF THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, ENTERED MARCH 12, 1991, SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 56536.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
