CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE WEEKS
TRAIL, OREGON 97541

confirms the right to use the waters of ELK CREEK, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION 9.7 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1894.

The use is limited to 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 6.8 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 2.9 ACRES
SECTION 35
TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 15856, as modified by an order of the Water Resources Director, enter August 21, 1991, approving Transfer 6364, and Certificate 66671, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 14, 1994, approving Transfer Application 7056.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
