## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHESTER WIRTZ AND JAS. MATHIESON BANKS, OR

confirms the right to use the waters of WIRTZ BRANCH, a tributary of EAST DAIRY CREEK, within the TUALATIN RIVER BASIN, for DOMESTIC USE.

This right was perfected under PERMIT 6010. The date of priority is AUGUST 20, 1923. The use is limited to 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW1/4 NE1/4 SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M. 500 FEET SOUTH AND 200 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, NWNE, SECTION 28.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE1/4 SW1/4
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.
