## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ANTHONY F & MARCELLA G VANDEHEY ROUTE 1, BOX 50 CORNELIUS, OR 97113

confirms the right to use the waters of the EAST DAIRY CREEK, a tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 0.5 acres.

This right was perfected under PERMIT 22437. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 25, 1953. The use is limited to 0.006 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 5 (SW1/4 SW1/4) SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M., 1170 FEET DUE EAST FROM SW CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

0.5 ACRES SE1/4 SW1/4
As projected within Cornelius DLC 41
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.
