CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

M. KENNETH HOSLER  
ROUTE 3, BOX 310  
SHERWOOD, OR 97140

confirms the right to use the waters of the A WELL, a tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 6.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4694. The date of priority is OCTOBER 10, 1969. The use is limited to 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE1/4 NW1/4, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.  
350 FEET NORTH AND 2050 FEET EAST FROM WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

6.0 ACRES SW1/4 NW1/4  
SECTION 31  
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 40824, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on February 28, 1995.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.
