## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

R.B. OLIVER IDLEYLD ROUTE ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION 73.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 24629. The date of priority is DECEMBER 17, 1956. This right is limited to 0.92 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, as projected within HUNTLEY DLC 38, SECTION 15, T 26 S, R 4 W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> 40.0 ACRES NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> 17.0 ACRES SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> 2.9 ACRES SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> 7.7 ACRES all as projected within HUNTLEY DLC 38 SECTION 15 TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 43557, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered <u>March 7, 1995</u>, approving Transfer Application 6829, and correctly describes that portion of the same water right NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 6, 1976, approving Transfer 3071.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
