CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. P. ALLEN

of Juntura, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Middle Fork of Malheur River
for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 228; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one and one-half acre
feet per acre in any 30-day period prior to June 1st, one acre foot per acre in any
30-day period after June 1st, of each year, or three acre feet per acre during any
season diverted at a rate not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per
acre; A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

30 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 37 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 15 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of
Section 20; 16 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 21 South, Range
38 E. W. M., being a total of 98 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
