CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of STRAWBERRY RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-11249, a tributary of MILLER CREEK, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 275.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 51080. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 9, 1990. This right is limited to 766.0 ACRE-FEET STORED WATER ONLY or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 8, T 40 S, R 16 E, W.M.; 1312 FEET NORTH AND 1172 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
