CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DALE R. BOYLE

confirms the right to use the waters of THE ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATING 0.8 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 18531. The date of priority is OCTOBER 28, 1948. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 4 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) SECTION 12, T 36 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 30 FEET NORTH AND 3390 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season FROM APRIL 2 TO OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 4 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) SECTION 12	0.2 ACRE
LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) SECTION 13	0.6 ACRE
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.	

When required by the Department the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantify of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 29, 1989, and together with Certificate 68469, supersedes Certificate 52041, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
