## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ALBERT ALTNOW

of Drewsey, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Warm Spring Creek, a tributary of Malheur River for Tract #1; Cottonwood Creek, a tributary of Malheur River, for Tract #2;

for the purpose of Irrigation and Storage for Tract #1; Irrigation for Tract #2;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 228; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from July 5, 1883 for Tract #1; March 13, 1885 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.75 cubic feet per second for Tract #1; and 1 1/2 acre feet per acre in any 30-day period prior to June 1st, 1 acre foot per acre in any 30-day period after June 1st, of each year, or three acre feet per acre during any season diverted at a rate not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per acre, for Tract #2.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1: 25 acres in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 20 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, 25 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 35 acres in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, 20 acres in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, 30 acres in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, and 5 acres in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, T. 20 S. R. 36 E. W. M., being a total of 160 acres.

(NOTE: No water to be taken for storage between May 15th and November 1st of each year. See Finding No. 13.)

Tract #2: 18 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, 37 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, 20 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, 15 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, 40 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, 35 acres in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 4, T. 20 S. R. 36 E. W. M., being a total of 165 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
