CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ESTATE OF ERWIN ABRAMSON
444 SOUTH H STREET
LAKEVIEW, OREGON 97630

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST BRANCH THOMAS CREEK, a tributary of GOOSE LAKE, for IRRIGATING 71.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 25070. The date of priority is APRIL 22, 1957. This right is limited to 1.78 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent, in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4) SECTION 30, T 38 S, R 20 E, W.M.;
4761.82 FEET NORTH AND 21.77 FEET EAST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 25,
T 38 S, R 19 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) 9.1 ACRES
LOT 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4) 35.8 ACRES
LOT 4 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) 26.3 ACRES
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 20 EAST, W.M.

The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 18, 1989, and supersedes Certificate 29012, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

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The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
