CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of an UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATING 6.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 15946. The date of priority is AUGUST 26, 1944. This right is limited to AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE ¼ SW ¼ SECTION 36, T 1 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1000 FEET NORTH AND 240 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTH ¼ CORNER SECTION 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be order by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW ¼ SE ¼ 6.3 ACRES
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 29, 1986, and supersedes Certificate 16729, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
