CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WIL WILSON
17900 MALLARD LANE, S.E.
DAYTON, OREGON 97114

confirms the right to use the waters of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 8.2 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 68.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 32243 and Permit 34436. The date of priority is APRIL 14, 1967, FOR USE OF 0.47 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, AND MAY 28, 1969, FOR USE OF 0.48 CFS. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.95 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

(ORIGINAL) NW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 58, SECTION 4, T 6 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 4700 FEET NORTH AND 1290 FEET EAST FROM THE SE CORNER OF DLC 58; (ADDITIONAL) NE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 51, SECTION 27, T 4 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1180 FEET SOUTH AND 2230 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new POINT OF DIVERSION, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

In the interest of conserving the waters of Palmer Creek, the supplemental portions of this water right may be exercised as the primary water right at times when Palmer Creek water is available.

This certificate is issued to confirm use of an additional point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 23, 1990, and together with Certificates 64748 and 64749, supersedes Certificates 51491 and 51492, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment
