CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CLARENCE R. STAPLES
6291 WILLIS CREEK ROAD
WINSTON, OREGON 97496

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of WEST WILLIS CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 42389. The date of priority is AUGUST 1, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.025 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 29 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 100 FEET NORTH AND 100 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 ACRE
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 ACRE AND DOMESTIC
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN H.D. WILLIS DLC 45
SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE, AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 49252.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
