CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GRAND RONDE COMMUNITY WATER ASSOCIATION  
26690 SALMON RIVER HIGHWAY  
WILLAMINA, OREGON 97396

confirms the right to use the waters of ROCK CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, for QUASI-MUNICIPAL.

This right was perfected under Permit 15608. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 22, 1943. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, T 6 S, R 8 W, W.M.: 530 FEET NORTH AND 165 FEET WEST OF THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 29, 1977, and supersedes Certificate 15613, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

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When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.30 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
