CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of JOHN DAY RIVER, for IRRIGATING 99.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 4036. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 3, 1919. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.24 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 15, T 9 S, R 26 E, W.M., 1470 FEET NORTH AND 2160 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4	7.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	24.0 ACRES
NE 1/4 SW 1/4	40.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	28.0 ACRES

SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 8, 1990, and together with Certificate 63836, supersedes Certificate 52197, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
