CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOWERS FARMS, INC. STAR ROUTE SILVER LAKE, OREGON 97638

confirms the right to use the waters of the BOARDMAN WELL in the FORT ROCK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 65.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6007. The date of priority is DECEMBER 9, 1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.81 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

LOT 2 (SW% NW%), SECTION 7, T 27 S, R 15 E, WM; 1430 FEET SOUTH AND 1380 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 1 (NW¼ NW¼) 32.5 ACRES
LOT 2 (SW¼ NW¼) 32.5 ACRES
SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The quantity of water diverted at this point of appropriation, together with the quantity of water diverted at any other points of appropriation developed under this permit, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 48731, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered $\frac{AUG}{A}$ 30 1995, approving Transfer Application 7300
