G E R T I F I C A T E O F W A T E R R I G H T (For Eights which have been confirmed by the Courts.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That THE OREGON & WESTERN COLONIZATION COMPANY. of Prineville, Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Paulina, Wolf. Ochoco, McKay, Powell, Lost, Beaver and Mill Creeks, tributaries of Crooked River, and Crooked River, a tributary of Deschutes River, for the purpose of irrigating 4892 acres of land, and stock and domestic use; and that sail right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grook County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 449; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1891 for the irrigation of Tract No. 1, from Paulina Creek; from 1906 for the irrigation of Tract No. 2, from Wolf Creek; from 1895 for the irrigation of Tract No. 3, from Ochoco Greek; from 1906 for the irrigation of Tract No. 4, from McKay Creek; from 1905 for the irrigation of Tract No. 5, from Powell Creek; from 1891 for the irrigation of Tract No. 6, from Grooked River; from 1907 for the irrigation of Tract No. 7, from Ochoco Creek; from 1885 for the irrigation of Track No. 8, from Lost Creek; from 1885 for the irrigation of Tract No. 9, from Crocked River; from 1368 for the irrigation of Tract No. 10, from Beaver Creek; from 1885 for the irrigation of Tract No. 11, from Crooked River; from 1873 for the irrigation of Tract No. 12, from Ochoco Creek; and from 1868 for the irrigation of Tract No. 13, from Mill Creek: that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 6.11/oubic feet per second for irrigation, the total quantity being limited to four core feet per acre during each year, and a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.
