## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That

has a right to the use of

the waters of

North Fork Indian

for the purpose of

Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 228; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1874

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed the acre feet per acre in any 30-day period after June 1st, of each year, or 3 acre feet per acre during any season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per account per acre;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

18.5 acros in the SWINE, 27 acros in the SEINE, 37.5 acros in the NEISE, 12.5 acros in the NEISE, 25 acros in the SWINE, and 20 acros in the SEINE, of Section 8, 17 acros in the SWINE, 8 acros in the NEISW, and 50 acros in the NEISW, Section 9, T. 18 S. R. 40 E. W. M., being a total of 195.5 acros.

(NOTE: Subject to use by Pacific Livestock Company on Indian Creek Ranch out of Middle or South Branch.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
