CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RUSSELL BASS
4580 BRUSH COLLEGE ROAD
SALEM, OREGON 97304

confirms the right to store the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of SPRING VALLEY CREEK, in AN UNNAMED RESERVOIR, appropriated under Permit 51338, for RECREATION.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-11413. The date of priority is AUGUST 13, 1991. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is 3.3 acre-feet. **THE APPROPRIATION OF WATER FOR STORAGE IS LIMITED TO THE PERIOD NOVEMBER 1 THROUGH MAY 31 OF EACH YEAR.**

The dam is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 36, T 6 S, R 4 W, W.M.

The area to be submerged by the reservoir is located within:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
