CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That DALTON BIGGS (Successor to DeArmond Land Company)
of Ontario, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Malheur River
for the purpose of Irrigation and Domestic

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8 at page 228; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from April 28, 1911

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.5 acre feet per acre
in any 30-day period prior to June 1st, 1 acre foot per acre in any 30-day period
after June 1st, of each year, or 3 acre feet per acre during any season, diverted
at a rate of not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per acre;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40 acres in the NE¹/₄SE¹/₄, 40 acres in the HW¹/₄SE¹/₄, 40 acres in the SW¹/₄SE¹/₄, 40 acres
in the SE¹/₄SE¹/₄, 22.7 acres in the SW¹/₄NE¹/₄, 21.5 acres in the SE¹/₄NE¹/₄, 28 acres in the
SW¹/₄NW¹/₄, 27 acres in the SE¹/₄NW¹/₄, 40 acres in the NE¹/₄SW¹/₄, 40 acres in the NW¹/₄SW¹/₄,
25 acres in the SW¹/₄SW¹/₄, 40 acres in the SE¹/₄SW¹/₄, Section 3, 34.4 acres in the SE¹/₄NE¹/₄,
16 acres in the NE¹/₄SE¹/₄, Section 4, 19.5 acres in the SW¹/₄SE¹/₄, 32 acres in the NE¹/₄SW¹/₄,
9 acres in the NW¹/₄SW¹/₄ and 1.5 acres in the SE¹/₄SW¹/₄ of Section 12, T. 19 S. R. 45
E. W. M., being a total of 516.6 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations
contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
