CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

has a right to the use of

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume April 28, 1911 page ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 12 acre feet per acre in any 30-day period prior to June 1st, 1 acre foot per acre in any 30-day period after June 1st, of each year, or 3 acre feet per acre during any season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per acre;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

40 acres in the NELSEL, 40 acres in the HVLSEL, 40 acres in the SVLSEL, 40 acres in the SEISE, 22.7 acres in the SWINE, 21.5 acres in the SEINE, 28 acres in the SWINE, 27 acres in the SEINE, 40 acres in the NEISWL, 40 acres in the NEISWL, 25 acres in the SWASWA, 40 acres in the SEASWA, Section 3, 34.4 acres in the SEARA, 16 acres in the WEASEA, Section 4, 19.5 acres in the SWASEA, 32 acres in the WEASWA, 9 acres in the NW1SW1 and 1.5 acres in the SE1SW1 of Section 12, T. 19 S. R. 45 E. W. M., being a total of 516.6 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
