CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WEBSTER BRIGGS

confirms the right to use the waters of THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of THE UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 16.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 21874. The date of priority is OCTOBER 31, 1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 56, SECTION 23, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 800 FEET NORTH AND 3090 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4	2.5 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	3.1 ACRES
NE 1/4 SW 1/4	3.5 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	3.7 ACRES

ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 53

SE 1/4 SW 1/4	2.2 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	1.0 ACRE

ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 56

SECTION 23  
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 30, 1991, and supersedes Certificate 47504, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
