## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the LITTLE PUDDING RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 22.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3771. The date of priority is AUGUST 3, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW% NW%, AS PROJECTED WITHIN ORCHARD DLC 59, SECTION 10, T 6 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 610 FEET NORTH AND 1920 FEET WEST FROM THE SW CORNER BENET DLC 58.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic feet per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
