CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MATTHEW AND DONNA EPSTEIN
2135 LITTLE APPLGATE ROAD
JACKSONVILLE, OR 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SEASONAL STREAM AND GINGG RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8306, a tributary of LITTLE APPLGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATING 2.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 46010. The date of priority is APRIL 20, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 12, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 3700 FEET NORTH AND 860 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.4 ACRES
SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining in-stream flows.
