CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CARL F. EHLIG  
291 DOG CREEK ROAD

confirms the right to use the waters of BRIMSTONE GULCH CREEK, a tributary of GRAVE CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES, INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE HALF ACRE LAWN OR NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN FOR EACH.

This right was perfected under Permit 50111. The date of priority is JUNE 29, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 8, T 34 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 96 FEET SOUTH AND 1309 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 8.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4  
SECTION 8  
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
