CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CARL F. EHLIG 291 DOG CREEK ROAD SUNNY VALLEY, OREGON 97497-9715

confirms the right to use the waters of BRIMSTONE GULCH CREEK, a tributary of GRAVE CREEK, for IRRIGATING 1.25 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 34563. The date of priority is JULY 30, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.014 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 8, T 34 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 96 FEET SOUTH AND 1309 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.25 ACRES SECTION 8 TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 18, 1990, and together with Certificate 64229, supersedes Certificate 45938, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
