CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KAY C. CLARK HC 60, BOX 4100 LAKEVIEW, OR 97630

confirms the right to use the waters of DREWS CREEK, a tributary of GOOSE LAKE, for IRRIGATING 62.72 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50650. The date of priority is MARCH 3, 1988. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.57 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 18, T 40 S, R 19 E, W.M.; 250.7 FEET NORTH AND 2469.4 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.40 ACRES SE 1/4 SE 1/4 35.12 ACRES SECTION 13 TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 18 EAST, W.M.

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 26.20 ACRES SECTION 18 TOWNSHIP 40 SCUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.

The use of water is subject to the terms and conditions of the stipulation between LAKEVIEW WATER USERS, INC. AND KAY C. CLARK, recorded at Page 2177, Volume 7, Miscellaneous Records of the Water Resources Director, and by reference made a part of this water right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only as times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
