CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the POWDER RIVER BASIN for MUNICIPAL USES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10922. The date of priority is DECEMBER 14, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 254 GALLONS PER MINUTE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 20, T 9 S, R 40 E, W.M.; 112.87 FEET SOUTH AND 99.9 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

WITHIN THE SERVICE AREA OF BAKER CITY

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior SURFACE AND GROUND WATER rights of others.

When required by the department, the user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
