CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DONALD H. CLARK 5490 WESTSIDE ROAD CAVE JUNCTION, OREGON 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of THE ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of THE ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATING 3.9 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is MAY, 1887.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.0 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR EACH 50 ACRES OF LAND IRRIGATED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM APRIL 1 TO NOVEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 6 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 33, T 38 S, R 8 W, W.M.; 620 FEET NORTH AND 1560 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 33, T 38 S, R 8 W, W.M.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 3.9 ACRES SECTION 4 TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 26, 1989, and together with Certificate 68700, supersedes Certificate 56496, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
