CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the BUCK CREEK BASIN for THE IRRIGATION OF 49.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-472. The date of priority is AUGUST 18, 1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.61 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 12, T 26 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 17.1 CHAINS SOUTH AND 22.8 CHAINS WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.2 ACRE
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 34.8 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 14.0 ACRES

SECTION 12
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 27978, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 25, 1977, approving Transfer Application T-3510.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
