CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE M. MAYFIELD LA PINE, OREGON 97739

confirms the right to use the waters of the EAST FORK DESCHUTES RIVER, now known as the LITTLE DESCHUTES RIVER, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATING 29.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DESCHUTES County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 9, at Page 362. The date of priority is 1897.

The amount to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount of water actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent from APRIL 1 TO MAY 23 and from AUGUST 20 TO NOVEMBER 1, and 0.73 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND from MAY 23 TO AUGUST 20 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) from APRIL 1 TO MAY 23 and from AUGUST 20 TO NOVEMBER 1, and ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) from MAY 23 TO AUGUST 20, and 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Lot 1 (NE¼ NE¼) 14.3 acres Lot 2 (NW¼ NE¼) 15.0 acres
