CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

A-D DAIRY; ANTHONY AGUIAR

confirms the right to use the waters of JUMP OFF JOE CREEK, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATING 47.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1875.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.671 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 35 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 508 FEET NORTH AND 1140 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 13.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4	4.6 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	3.5 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	20.0 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	18.9 ACRES

SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 27, 1989, and together with Certificate 62736, supersedes Certificate 16497, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
