CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the SPRAGUE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 236.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10140. The date of priority is APRIL 22, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.95 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 36 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 100 FEET SOUTH AND 30 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 16 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4)	2.7 ACRES
LOT 17 (NE 1/4 SE 1/4)	17.3 ACRES
LOT 24 (NE 1/4 SE 1/4)	20.0 ACRES
LOT 25 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4)	20.0 ACRES
LOT 32 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4)	19.5 ACRES

SECTION 21

TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
