CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 15.2 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 18659. The date of priority is MARCH 23, 1949. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.29 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 27, NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 34, NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 33, T 4 N, R 28 E, W.M.; (ADDITIONAL) - 140 FEET NORTH AND 710 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 27; (ADDITIONAL) - 750 FEET SOUTH AND 50 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 34; (ORIGINAL) - 405 FEET SOUTH AND 800 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4        4.0 ACRES  
SECTION 28  
  
NW 1/4 NE 1/4        11.2 ACRES  
SECTION 33  
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm ADDITIONAL POINTS OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 25, 1985, and together with certificate 53261 supersedes certificate 24196, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

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The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
