CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That CLARENCE W. DRINKWATER

of Drewsey, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Otis Creek for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 223; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1884

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed five cubic feet per second;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

12 acres in the SE 1/4, 7 acres in the NW 1/4, Section 31, 12.5 acres in the NW 1/4, 25 acres in the SW 1/4 and 27 acres in the NW 1/4, Section 32, T. 20 S. R. 56 E. W. 4., being a total of 93.5 acres.

(NOTE: Subject to rights of S. S. Williams to irrigate lands under Stewart Ditch described in said decree.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
