CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT (HB - 2153)

confirms the right to store the waters of
AN UNNAMED STREAM IN ROBCO FREE RESERVOIR, SOUTH FORK BEAVER CREEK
IN CCC CAMP RESERVOIR AND CORRAL CREEK IN EAST CHINQUAPIN MOUNTAIN
RESERVOIR, TRIBUTARIES OF BEAVER CREEK AND BEAVER CREEK IN BEAVER CREEK
3 RESERVOIR, A TRIBUTARY OF JENNY CREEK
for STOCK WATERING AND INDUSTRIAL USE.

The right to store and use these waters was perfected under Reservoir Application R-73682.
The date of priority is January 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and
used each year under this right is not more than 0.228 ACRE-FEET, BEING
0.135 AF FROM ROBCO FREE RESERVOIR, 0.053 AF FROM CCC CAMP RESERVOIR
, 0.014 AF FROM EAST CHINQUAPIN MOUNTAIN RESERVOIR AND 0.026 FROM BEAVER
CREEK 3 RESERVOIR

Located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST WM.
NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST WM.
NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST WM.
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST WM.


The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, with
a minimum diameter of 8", or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary
for public safety or to satisfy prior downstream rights as determined by the Water Resources Director.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of
use listed above.
