and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume B, at page 223 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from Sept. 1887 for Tract #1; 1896 for Tract #2;

that the amount of water to which such right is cultiled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 12 acre feet per acre in any 30-day period prior to June 1st, 1 acre feet per acre in any 50-day period after June 1st, of cach year. or 5 acre feet per acre during any season, diverted at a rate not to exceed ono-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per acre;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract #1: 6.5 acres in the NE'SW', 6.5 acres in the NE'SW', Section 21, 3 acres in the NE'SE', Section 20, T. 23 S. R. 37 E. W. M., being a total of 16 acres.

Tract #2: 4 acres in the NE¹₂SE¹₂, Section 20, 13.5 acres in the NE¹₂SW¹₂, 15.5 acres in the NW¹₂SW¹₂ and 27 acres in the SE¹₂SW¹₂, Section 21, T. 23 S. R. 37 E. W. M., being a total of 58 acres.

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And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
