and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 228; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1892

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1½ acre foot per acre in any 50-day period after June 1st, of each year, or 3 acre feet per acre during any season, diverted at a rate not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per acre;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

20.5 acres in $SV_{2}^{1}NV_{2}^{1}$, 19.5 acres in $NE_{2}^{1}SV_{2}^{1}$, 10.5 acres in $NV_{2}^{1}SV_{2}^{1}$, Section 12, T. 18 S. R. 43 E. W. M., being a total of 50.5 acres.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
