CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That HOPE BROTHERS

of Vale, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Malheur River for the purpose of Power

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 228; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1897

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed the diversion of 100 cubic feet per second for the development of 125 H.P. under a 11 ft. fall;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Place of use on NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 30, T. 18 S. R. 45 E. W. M.

(NOTE: Irrigation rights claimed by Hope Brothers in their testimony are tabulated under City of Vale and Gellerman-Froman Ditch Company. See also under Malheur Farmers' Irrigating Company.)

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
