confirms the right to store the waters of
WALLUPA CREEK, WILDCAT BRANCH, BISHOP CREEK, MUD CREEK AND CLEAR
CREEK, TRIBUTARIES OF GRANDE RONDE RIVER IN RESERVOIR 250, 287,
1045, 720, 832 AND 1277
for WILDLIFE, LIVESTOCK, AESTHETICS AND RECREATION.

The right to store and use these waters was perfected under Reservoir Application R-75568.
The date of priority is January 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and
used each year under this right is not more than 28.1 ACRE-FEET, BEING
1.1 AF IN RESERVOIR 250, 1.3 AF IN RESERVOIR 287, 7.8 AF IN
RESERVOIR 1045, 3.5 AF IN RESERVOIR 720, 3.4 AF IN RESERVOIR 832,
AND 11.0 AF IN RESERVOIR 1277


