CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under reservoir permits)

This is to Certify, That RICHARD L. SCOTT

of Beulah, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Jerry Creek, tributary of North Fork of Malheur River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of lands described in Permit No. 1278; that the Scott Reservoir has been constructed

under Reservoir Permit No. 165 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 168, on the 18th day of November, 1914; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 12, 1912

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 146 acre feet.

The reservoir is located in Section twenty-six, Tp. 18 S., R. 37 E., W. M.
